

What is your part in the MOMS Club?

First and foremost, every MOMS Club member is expected to have fun and enjoy herself. That is the main goal of the club. In order for everyone to enjoy themselves, we must put in place some basic rules and courtesies for everyone to follow.

1. Each member is responsible for the safety and actions of her own child(ren). You may be required to remove a disruptive or ill child from a meeting or activity. As soon as the situation is rectified, you and your child may return. Final decision as to whether or not to remove a child rests with the executive board.
2. You are required to keep your MOMS Club roster private. You may not share it with prospective members or those wishing to target the group for advertisement. Only current paid members will be included in the roster or given a copy.
3. Every MOMS Club has a service project at least once per year. It is our way of giving back to the community. Each member is expected to help with the service project in some way or another. We realize that not everyone has the same time or skills. Your part of the service project may be as simple as calling five people with reminders.
4. During your membership, you may be called upon to volunteer for other committees and projects. For all volunteer jobs (this goes for the service project too) it is your responsibility to say no when you have to. Each member's first responsibility is to her family and we do not wish to infringe on that in any way.
5. Each member is expected to keep her annual membership current. The MVP or the treasurer will let you know when it is time to renew. Also, if at any time the dues are a hardship for your family, please talk to one of the executive board members. We're here to help and we want to keep the club open to everyone.
6. Help ensure the club rules are being followed. If you see rules being broken or situations that could be harmful then you are expected to take it to the executive board. Unless it is completely impossible, we will respect your right to confidentiality.
7. All attendees will refrain from smoking at all MOMS Club functions. During outdoor functions, smoking will be permitted as long as reasonable respect is given to non-smokers and children.
